Note: In FY2014, cost sharing of Real World Externship programming with 15 businesses throughout the state of Iowa totaled \$95,000 in charitable contributions to the Governor’s STEM Advisory Council or directly to UNI.

Other business/corporate/grantor opportunities currently in progress or researching:

1. **Zoom.Us** – In conversations with Zoom executives to pitch \$50,000 proposal, as well as discuss potential discounted pricing structure for their product with Iowa STEM Corporate Partners.
2. **Pella Corporation** – Initial conversations with Governmental Relations individuals to discuss current STEM business outreach. They are helping to make introductions to Pella Rolscreen Foundation.
3. **Rockwell Collins** – Invitation to submit proposal for annual funding. Applications due between August 1 and August 31.
4. **John Deere Foundation** – Met with Pat Barnes and JD Foundation personnel to discuss current Iowa STEM programming and future interests/opportunities for funding.
5. **Alcoa** – Initial meeting with Riverside General Manager and VP of Human Resources to introduce Iowa STEM programming. Alcoa charitable giving more community focused, but will entertain a combined proposal for state/region, which I am working on.
6. **Eaton Corporation (Shenandoah)** – Each of three Eaton facilities in Iowa has their own opportunity for charitable giving, and preparing a proposal for this location to benefit regional/state STEM initiatives.
7. **Alliant Energy** – Introducing Iowa STEM to Alliant Energy through Cedar Rapids office and contacts. Asked to follow up with them in September as they prepare their budget for next year.
8. **Interstates Company** – Initial introduction of Governor's STEM Advisory Council to CEO and request. Invitation to follow up for more information on charitable giving through their corporate charitable giving.
9. **American Honda Foundation** – Researching timelines and STEM proposal opportunities for statewide Iowa STEM ask. Next application deadline due August 1, 2014
